Inclement Weather Policy

ISCC is a non-profit religious organization that primarily serves the Muslim community residing in and around Carroll County, Maryland. It provides weekly Jumma prayers and Islamic education for children through Iqra Academy every Sunday. In addition, it also sponsors various social gatherings such as pot-luck dinners, picnics and fund-raising events. This inclement weather policy relates to all activities sponsored by ISCC.

ISCC considers the safety and security of our community members a top priority.

If weather conditions are not optimal for travel or the premises are not safe to be occupied, then ISCC will err on the side of caution and cancel the relevant activity. ISCC will notify community members by 8 a.m. on the day through text messages, social media (Whatsapp and Facebook) and posting on the main ISCC website www.isccmd.org.

If there is no notification from ISCC, then all activities will proceed as planned. However, if community members feel it is unsafe to travel (local conditions can vary, particularly, with snow and ice), then they should give priority to their own safety. ISCC does not wish any community member to put his/her life at risk to attend an ISCC activity.
